KNOW YOUR RIGHTS



- **Don't** run or resist
- Ask, "Am I free to go?" BEFORE you say your name or anything else
- Don't lie or provide false information
- **Don't** consent to a search



- **Don't** answer questions about your criminal history or immigration status
- Ask why they stopped you and if they have an arrest warrant
- Don't consent to a search
- Leave if you're not under arrest



- Keep your door closed and stay inside
- ICE must provide a JUDGE ISSUED warrant in order to enter
- Ask for the warrant to be slipped under the door and ensure it is addressed to a specific resident of the household before letting them in
